LIGHT CITY 2018: Pedicab Operator
April 11 - 21, 2018

This April, the Baltimore Office of Promotions & The Arts (BOPA) will present a major new work by internationally-acclaimed artist Cai Guo-Qiang. Light City is pleased to feature *Fireflies*, an interactive artwork as a special addition to this year's BGE Light Art Walk. Curated by Fung Collaboratives, *Fireflies* is comprised of 27 illuminated kinetic sculptures. Over 900 handmade lanterns are attached to the top of 27 working pedicabs that festival goers may ride. Each lantern is handcrafted in Cai Guo-Qiang's hometown of Quanzhou, China, drawing on memories of the traditional lantern festivals of the artist's childhood.

BOPA has partnered with Velo-Park to manage all pedicab operations. Velo-Park is currently seeking high-energy, responsible individuals with strong communication skills and experience in tourism, hospitality, or customer service to participate as Pedicab Operators for the project. Pedicab Operators for *Fireflies* will operate the pedicabs for the event beginning Saturday, April 14 through to Saturday, April 21, 2018 with the main task of providing engaging pedicab service in a safe and responsible manner.

Requirements: Must be 18 years old and have a valid driver's license, the ability to physically operate a pedicab for 5 hours nightly, and possess a functioning cell phone. Operators will be paid per shift, shifts are tentatively scheduled to run 6:00PM-11:00PM during weekday nights and until 12:00AM on Friday and Saturday during the course of the event. Transportation to and parking at the festival is on your own.

Please Note: Pedicab training sessions begin upon hiring. In addition to the regular run of the project, there will be an opening night parade on April 14. To prepare for this special installation, pedicab operators will need to participate in two paid technical rehearsals on Wednesday and Thursday, April 11 and 12 and a paid dress rehearsal on Friday, April 13.
