SCHOOL 33 ART CENTER'S OPEN STUDIO TOUR SHOWCASES
THE TALENTS OF AREA ARTISTS

Visit Artists' Workspaces during Self-guided Tour on October 13 & 14, 2018

School 33 Art Center's Open Studio Tour celebrates the 30th year of its annual showcase of artist studios throughout Baltimore City on **Saturday, October 13 and Sunday, October 14, 2018** from **10am to 6pm**. The citywide event invites the public into artists' workspaces to view or purchase original works of art, meet the artists and get a behind-the-scenes glimpse into their creative processes. More than 100 Baltimore-based artists working in an array of visual media, including painting, sculpture, photography and digital media, participate in this year's tour.

The anniversary weekend begins with a kick off event on Friday, October 12, 2018 from 6pm to 9pm, held together with the opening reception for School 33 Art Center's fall exhibitions: "ALLLLL NATURAL," in the Main Gallery, curated by Adriel Luis and featuring artists Selin Balci, Maggy Gourlay, Caroline Hatfield, Kaitlin O'Keefe, Catherine Mapp, Antoinette Suiter and Chiang Tai; Rachel and Jon Lundak's Member's Gallery show "Traveling Home;" and "Wandering Properties" by Bryan Funk in the Project Space.

Open Studio Tour is held in conjunction with Free Fall Baltimore and National Arts & Humanities Month, which take place every October 1-31. School 33 Art Center's Open Studio Tour is produced by School 33 Art Center, which is managed by the **Baltimore Office of Promotion & The Arts (BOPA)**.
