



**2021 Baltimore Farmers' Market & Bazaar  
Bazaar Applicants - Schedule Options (no food/farms)**

When completing the 2021 application, the three schedule and payment options to choose from are outlined below:

**A. Full Season**

Vendor Fee: \$1,320

- "Full Season" option grants you:
  - Reserved Bazaar placement for all 38 Sundays from April 4, 2021 to December 19, 2021.
  - Business name placement on the official 2021 Baltimore Farmers' Market & Bazaar Map.
  - Business name and link on our website.
  - \$200.00 discount (already applied).
- Three payment installments: (Payment is nonrefundable / not contingent on the number of Sundays attended.)
  - \$440 due by April 4, 2021
  - \$440 due by July 4, 2021
  - \$440 due by October 3, 2021

**B. Trimesters**

Vendor Fee: \$480 - **Trimester 1** (April 4, 2021 – June 27, 2021) 13 weeks

\$480 - **Trimester 2** (July 4, 2021 – September 26, 2021) 13 weeks

\$440 - **Trimester 3** (October 3, 2021 – December 19, 2021) 12 weeks

- "Trimester" option grants you:
  - Bazaar placement during the Trimester(s) you choose.
  - Flexibility to choose the months you would like to vend.
  - \$40.00 discount per a Trimester (already applied).
- Payment is due prior to the start of a Trimester: (Payment is nonrefundable / not contingent on the number of Sundays attended.)
  - Trimester 1 is due by April 4, 2021
  - Trimester 2 is due by July 4, 2021
  - Trimester 3 is due by October 3, 2021

**C. Occasional Sundays**

Vendor Fee: \$40 – per a Sunday

- "Occasional Sundays" option grants you:
  - Flexibility of not committing to a contracted vending schedule, however vending space is based on availability and is not guaranteed.
- Vendors use the Eventbrite system to check availability, and sign-up weekly between 9AM on Monday – 9AM on Friday. If all spaces are full or the link for that week closes, then the vendor must wait until the following week.
