Caterers, photographers, florists, and more will be available to help with all planning needs to create the perfect wedding at this historic landmark of Maryland. Open Houses showcase the stunning architecture of the rental facility while connecting guests to a full array of excellent wedding vendors. The first Open House takes place on **Saturday, January 11**, from **11am-3pm**. Additional Open Houses are scheduled for **Saturday, January 25** and **Saturday, February 8**, also from **11am-3pm**. The Cloisters is managed by the **Baltimore Office of Promotion & The Arts (BOPA)** and is located at **10440 Falls Rd., Lutherville, MD 21093**.

The historic Cloisters Castle dates back to 1932, with many of the architectural elements being far older, lending the house an ancient feel. Castle features include a four-story spiral stair tower, chapel, cloistered garden, windmill, elaborate stained-glass windows and doors, multiple fireplaces, hand-painted murals, ornamental ironwork and balconies. During Cloisters Open Houses throughout the year, the medieval-inspired attraction and rental facility hosts local vendors including caterers, photographers, florists, DJs and bridal shops.
